The ideal candidate will support and develop the current ministry of youth work in the Parish Church, supported by the congregation. The candidate will need to be a committed Christian who is passionate about sharing their faith with a desire to see young people find and grow in faith themselves.

- Able to communicate the gospel effectively
- Experience in the pastoral care and discipling of young people
- Good communication, presentation and organisational skills
- Signing the Youth for Christ Statement of Faith and Code of Conduct

- Understand young people's culture and the challenges they face
- Being up to date with current youth work practices and willing to understand and implement new developments.
- Being a self-motivated and self-disciplined team player
- Being flexible to include evening and weekend work
- Being able to drive

Water Orton is small village on the outskirts of Birmingham and very accessible with a train station located centrally. We are a vibrant community with an active Church, Cricket Club, Rugby club, Scouts, Boys' Brigade, tennis club and open green spaces. The village has two pubs, a small supermarket, Chinese takeaway, Pizza shop and chip shop. The primary school is well supported and has strong links with the church.
