For peace and reconciliation...



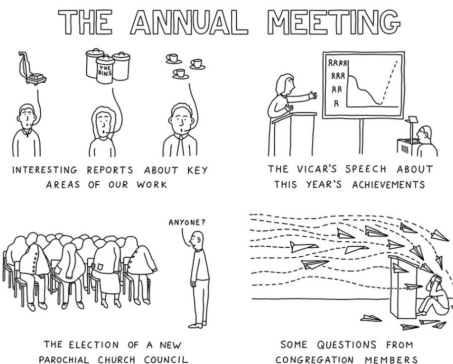
