Children Of Light

Paul Murray reflects on Ephesians 5: 8-11

Halloween is behind us again - thank goodness! It's not an easy time for believers in Jesus Christ. The same questions each year. Shall I answer the door, or not? Should I give out some sweets or maybe give them a "Jesus loves you" sticker.

Our reaction may depend on our mood that day. Whatever way we handle it, Christians are often on the back foot at Halloween. Let us never forget that in John 1:5 we see that the light [of Jesus] shines in the darkness but the darkness has not overcome it.

Ephesians 5:8 tells us to have nothing to do with fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them. Let's give a firm "No" to any involvement with the dominion of darkness. As the hymn says, "No Turning Back".

1 Thessalonians 5:5 reminds us that if we trust in the Lord Jesus then we are all children of the light and children of the day. We do not belong to the night or the darkness. So, our path ahead is clear. As the Apostle Paul wrote: I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 3:14)




