The Two Comings of Advent

Paul Murray reflects on Isaiah 9:6-7

For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given and the government will be upon His shoulders. He will be called Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His government and of peace there will be no end. He will reign on the throne of David and over His kingdom, to establish and sustain it with justice and righteousness from now on and forever.

It's that time of year again, where we all become so absorbed in the frenetic activity associated with Christmas. These two verses demonstrate a common feature of prophetic Scripture. Two parts of a prophecy separated by a long period of time. Isaiah tells us about the Christ-child being born and bringing peace, and that message is what we see on Christmas cards.

The same cards miss out on the oft-forgotten part of the story - the return of Jesus. He will run the world government from the throne of David (in Jerusalem) and His reign will be full of His peace, righteousness and justice.

There could be a niche in the market for someone to make Christmas cards depicting that scene!!

Would you be ready if Jesus was to return soon? It won't be long now. Let's remember that while we are eating the turkey!


