

CHRISTIAN AID WEEK WATER ORTON May 11th - 17th 2025

Water Orton responds amazingly each year to this appeal by Christian Aid, an organization that believes in equality and justice and is active in war, natural disaster and climate change high risk areas.

Each year, in various ways, the village does slightly better, smashing new targets -a particular satisfaction for the youth groups and leaders who do a large part of the door to door collection.

Rather than moving, Aurelia is learning and teaching others to manage change effectively in her community and country. Result!

COLESHILL FIRE SERVICE

Did you know that you are 4 times as likely to die in a fire if you don't have a smoke alarm; 21 people die each year because the battery in their smoke alarm was flat or missing at the time of the fire; Around half of home fires are caused by cooking accidents; 3 fires a day are started by candles; Every 5 days someone dies from a fire caused by a cigarette; Faulty electrics (appliances, wiring and overloaded sockets) cause around 6,000 fires in the home, across the country, every year.

Coleshill Fire Service offer a "Safe and Well" visit, to test your smoke and Carbon Monoxide alarms (if you have them) and give advice on keeping your home safe.. To see if you are eligible for a free visit please telephone 01675 462 007, between 9.00a.m. and 4.00p.m for further information.
